New Horizon: The approval of opening LEC University Distance Learning

- Overview of LEC University Distance Learning : Media Flex
- Our views on points of concern expressed by the Council

Today, the Council for University Chartering and School Juridical Person will submit a report approving the opening of LEC Tokyo Legal Mind University Distance Learning to the Minister of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology. Since the course is completely different from traditional distance learning, to distinguish our program from it, we call it “Media Flex”.

With the final green light of the Minister, LEC University School of Career Development will open “Media Flex” in 9 campuses nationwide. (Sapporo, Chiba, Shinjuku, Yokohama, Shizuoka, Kobe, Okayama, Hiroshima, and Matsuyama)

LEC University which now offers 4-year undergraduate courses in career development at 11 campuses, and a 2-year professional accountancy graduate course at Chiyoda campus has become a fully fledged University specializing in practical, professional education.

Educational Concept	Implementation of work related learning; “Career Education”. Our students will acquire business ability, knowledge, and professional ethics, to lead intelligent society in the years to come.
Educational Features	In keeping with the educational concept, <u>every student has contact with career consultants</u> from the beginning of enrollment. <u>In principle, 30 students will compose a class, and each class has a homeroom teacher</u> who consults with students about daily life and study. Guardian interviews, career development camps, and various guest speakers’ lectures will be held regularly. <u>Specialized subjects can be chosen freely from 10 programs</u> , and students are free to change programs.
Class style	<u>Our program is totally different from traditional distance learning. Media Flex is not an in-home course that sends materials to students’ homes, and marks students’ papers by mail.</u> Students belong to a school and <u>all courses require attendance</u> to attain credits. Class styles are two types: “Face to Face class” in which a teacher gives a live lecture, and “Media class” in which students take a lecture performed at another school by means of recorded media. “Media class” videos are available to students at <u>any time they want</u> . Credit acquired for Media classes is limited to 60 credits out of 124 for the ordinary day course, but “Media Flex” is not limited in this way. <u>Media Flex allows students to choose</u> between Face to Face, or Media classes, requiring only 22 subject credits for Face to Face classes. In most respects Media Flex is no different from a day course in which students attend a school and take classes. The difference is that Media Flex removes credit limitations regarding the type of class, and it creates an appropriate attendance system to <u>fit students’ requests and allow for individual selection of the most effective class type</u> .
Details	Alongside Media Flex, LEC University offers an ordinary day course, “Media Plus”. In “Media Plus” at least 64 credits out of 124 must be received for Face to Face classes; up to 60 credits can be received for Media classes. <u>The same degree (B.A. in Career Development) is to be awarded for both Media Flex and Media Plus. Student ID, school certificate, diploma, and academic transcript are the same</u> for both courses. Markings such as “Media Flex”, “day

	course”, “correspondence course” or “distance learning” do not appear on any of the documents.
